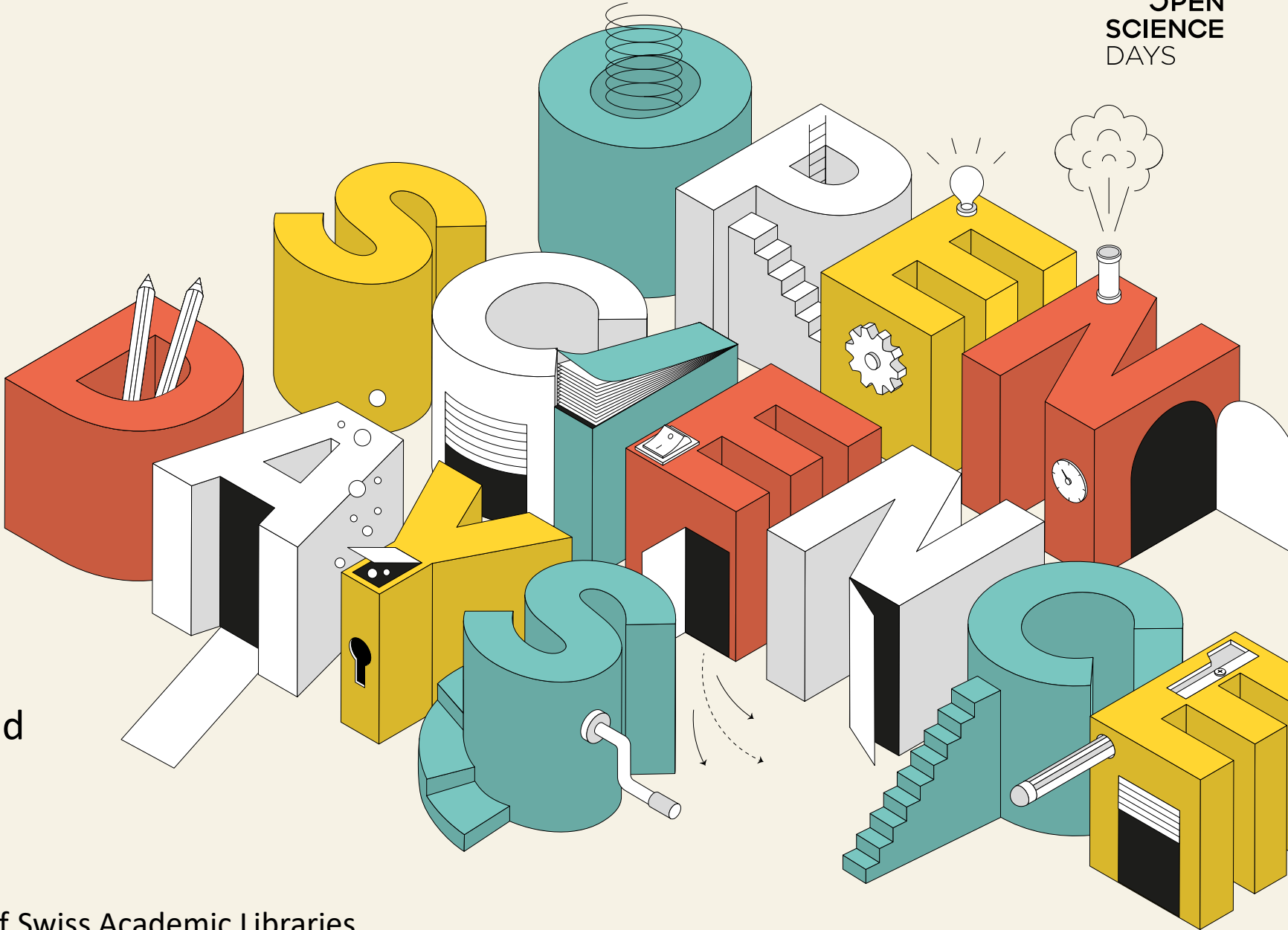

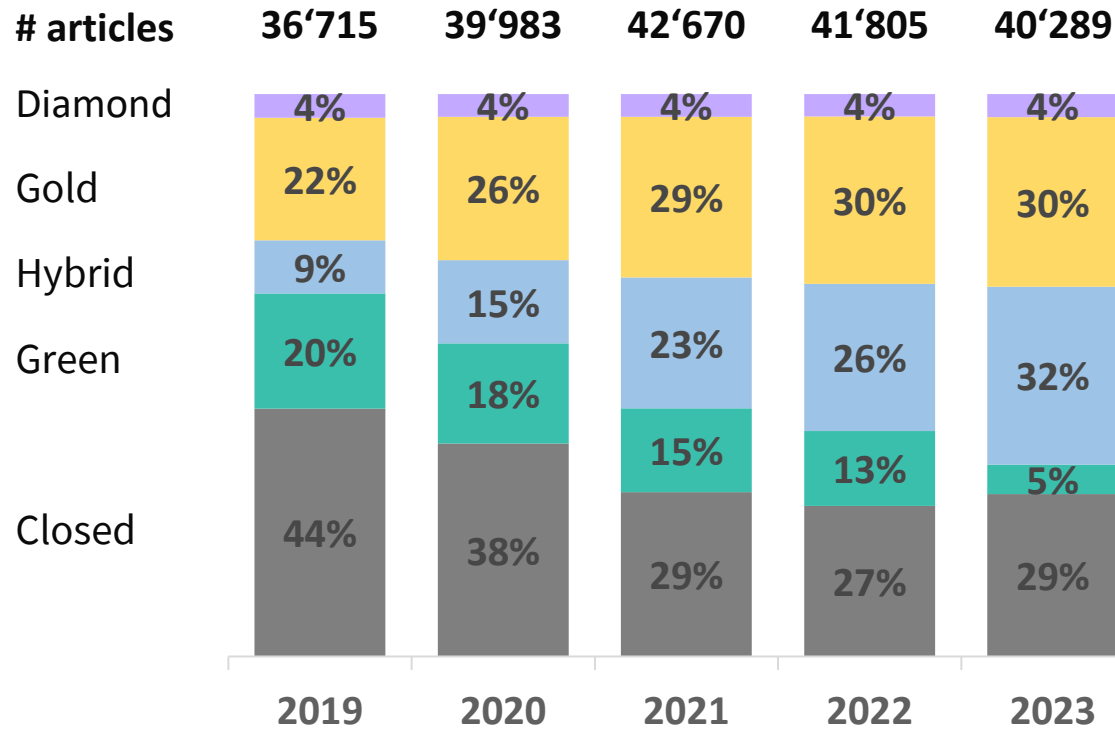

Development of Open Access in Switzerland

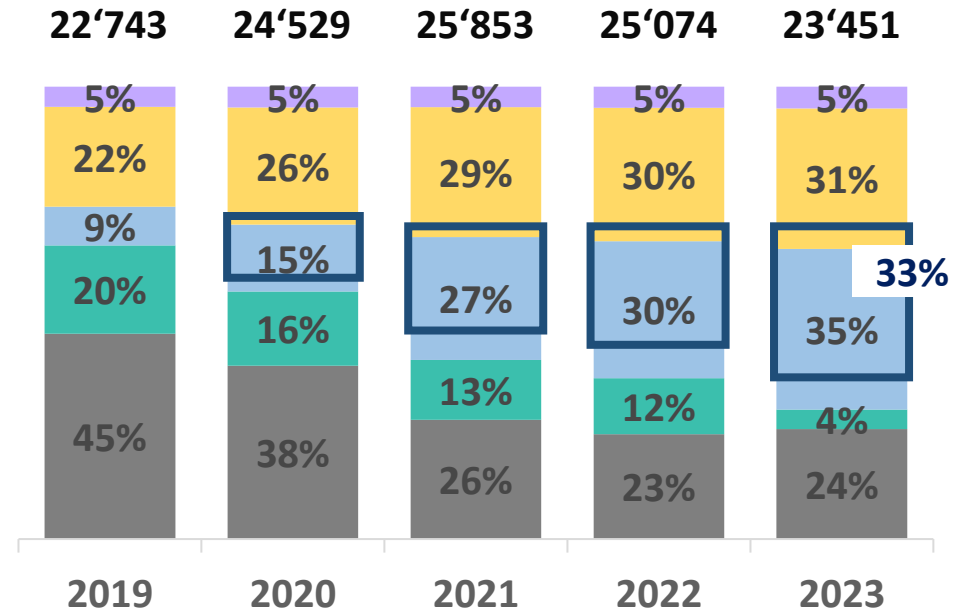
Open Access shares per year, Switzerland, in percent

All articles with CH author



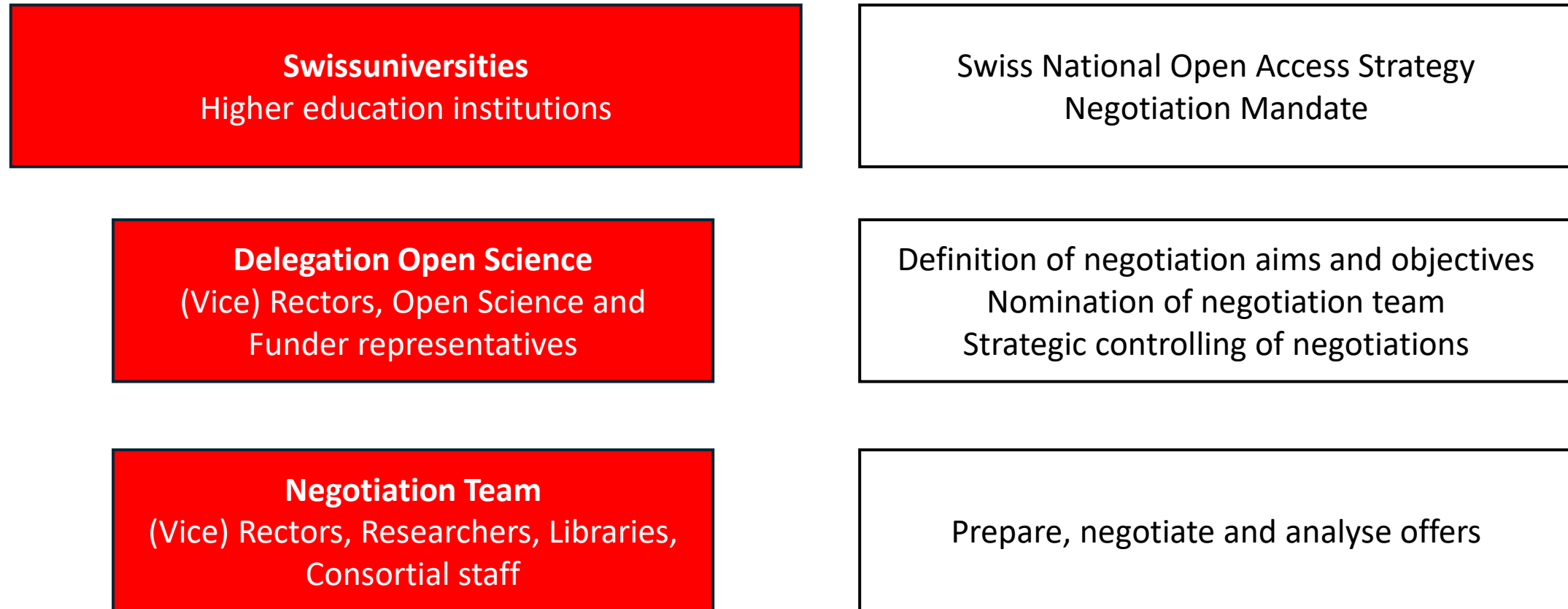
Articles with CH corresponding author

Negotiation aims

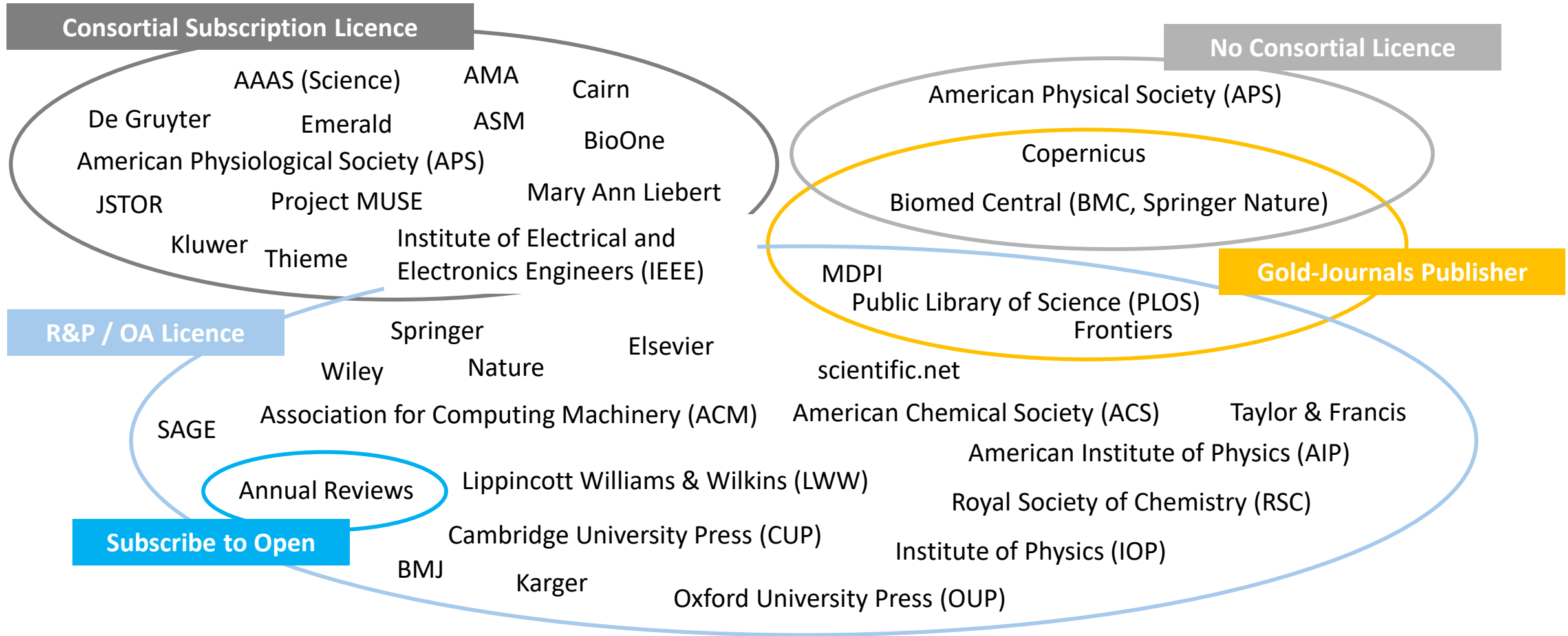
Core provision	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Read and publish rights. Core provision of the agreement.• Open Access publishing (including hybrid journals like Nature, Cell, Lancet, etc.) and Gold OA titles and brands (e.g. BioMed Central).
Pricing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cost neutrality on national level for entire publisher journal portfolio, based on existing spend for transformative agreements, additional licences (Nature journals) and Gold OA. Inflation may have to be accounted for.

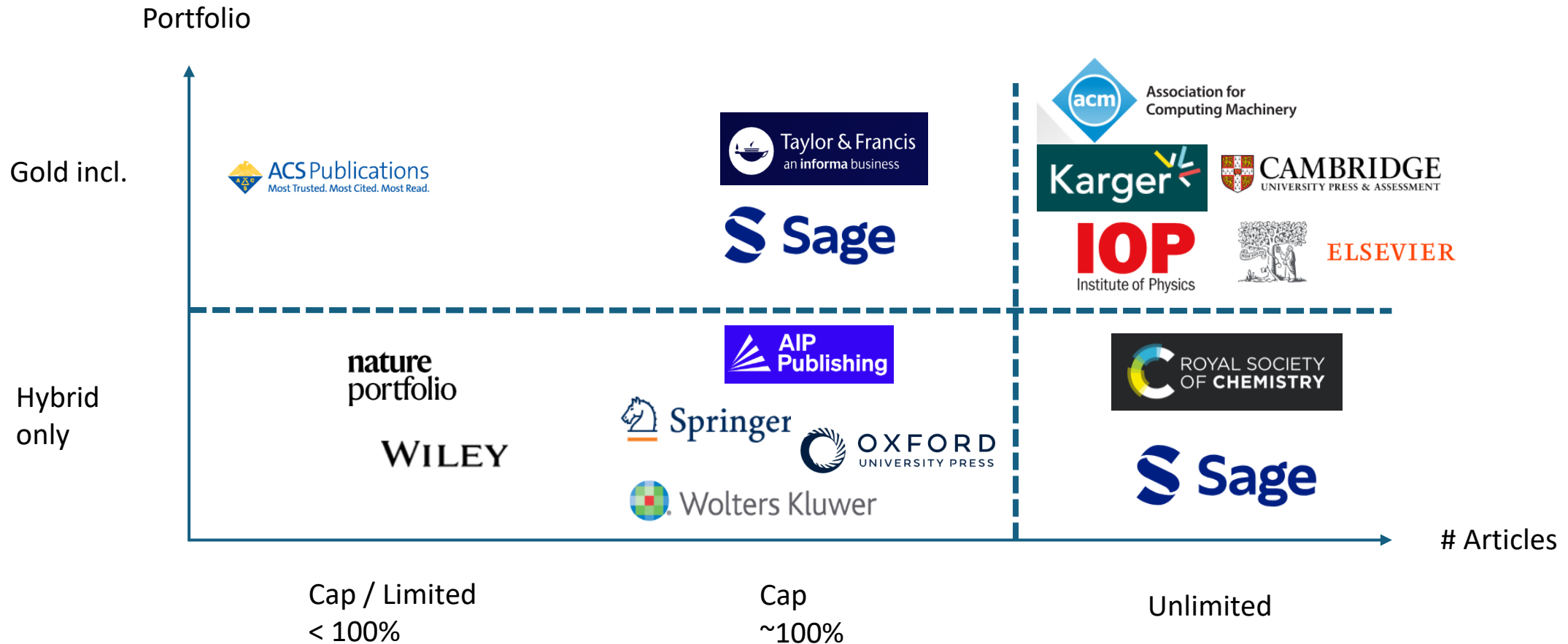
Journal Licences by Licence Type

Consortial journal licences, Switzerland, 2024



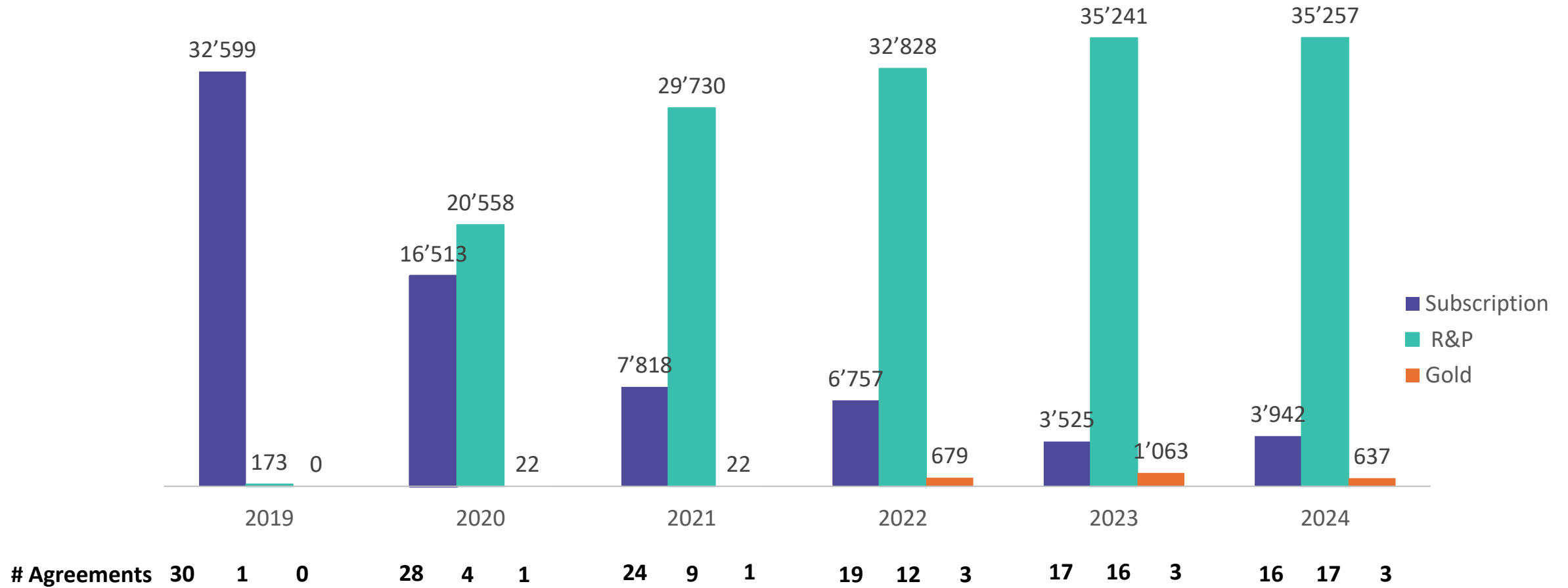
Range of Read & Publish Licence Models
